Greg Vogelsang P.Geog takes office as President of Geoscientists Canada for 2013-2014

On June 1st at the 16th Annual Meeting of Geoscientists Canada, Greg Vogelsang P.Eng., P.Geog, took office as President 2013-2014, after serving a year as its President-Elect. Mr. Vogelsang resides in Regina, Saskatchewan, where he provides professional Environmental Management consulting services to Western Potash Corp.

Geoscientists Canada, which is the business name of the Canadian Council of Professional Geoscientists, is the national organization of the 10 provincial and territorial licensing bodies/ordre that regulate the practice of geoscience in Canada.

Mr. Vogelsang is a graduate of the Northern Alberta Institute of Technology and the University of Regina (B.Sc.-Geology). He is a registered Professional Geoscientist and Professional Engineer in Saskatchewan and in Alberta.

His professional career includes 15 years as a consultant to a western Canada based consulting firm and 7 years as a mines inspector with the Government of Saskatchewan-Ministry of Environment located in Prince Albert, Saskatchewan.

Greg previously represented Saskatchewan on the Board of Directors of Geoscientists Canada. In June 2012 upon being elected President Elect, he rejoined the Board of Directors of Geoscientists Canada and joined the Executive Committee.

In fulfilling his duties as President, together with colleagues on the Executive Committee, Mr. Vogelsang will be focusing his attention on the concluding work directed at the strategic objectives for the organization as set by the Board of Directors of Geoscientists Canada in its 2010-2015 Strategic Plan. He also looks forward to working with the constituent associations and other stakeholders in developing a new strategic plan for the organization that will guide its activities for the remainder of the decade and beyond,
